

**HORSHAM WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY  
TAPPING FEE SCHEDULE  
Effective December 1, 2006**

Sewer capacity & collection portions only – per equivalent dwelling unit \$5,800

The Distribution/Capacity portions of the Authority's water tapping fees are based on meter size\* and are as follows:

- a. 5/8" x 3/4" – Two Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$2,600.00)
- b. 3/4" – Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)
- c. 1" - Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$7,200.00)
- d. 1 1/2" - Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$19,200.00)
- e. 2" – Thirty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000.00)
- f. 3" – Fifty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$59,800.00)
- g. 4" - One Hundred Eighty Six Thousand Dollars (\$186,000.00)
- h. 6" – Three Hundred Seventy Three Thousand (\$373,000.00)

\*in the case of multiple services (privately or Authority owned) preceded by a compound or combination meter, the tapping fee is based upon the *greater* of the domestic component of the compound or combination meter, or the total of the fees resulting from the fee accompanying the meter size that would be provided to each individual service regardless of whether each service is independently metered. Any non-residential customer with extended hours of business or utilizing shift-work, will be subject to paying multiples of the tapping fee based upon duration of the extended hours or the number of shifts utilized.

\*water tapping fee amounts reflected are capacity/distribution portion of tapping fee ONLY and are NOT inclusive of connection and customer facility fee components of tapping fee. The connection and customer facility fee components are variable based on length of service, varying restoration requirements based on location of water main to which tap is being installed, as well as current labor & material rates. All costs incurred incident to the installation of the meter and service connection from the main to the curb/ROW (or, if necessary, from the curb/ROW to the structure) as well as inspection will be charged to the property owner/customer. Total water tapping fee is calculated upon application for water service.

The Authority application and inspection fee is \$200.

Additional Special Purpose Tapping Fee of \$1,500 is due for connections on the following streets: Willowbrook Road, Evergreen Road and Davis Grove Road from Keith Valley to the first fire hydrant past Willowbrook Road.

Seasonal usage for camps, recreational pursuits, and similar activities operated or conducted by not for profit entities possessing a designation as a 501(c)(3) entity may pay pro-rated water tapping fees as follows: 9/25/06

- 90 consecutive days or less 25%
- 91-180 consecutive days 50%
- 181 consecutive days or more 100%
