

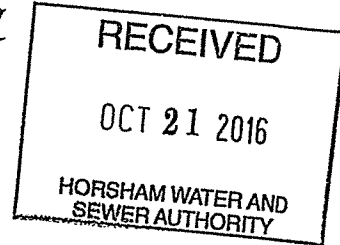

Dear Ms. O'Rourke:

Thank you for your participation in the discussion regarding PFC contamination of drinking water in Pennsylvania communities that I hosted on September 22. I appreciate you taking the time to come to Washington for the conversation, and I hope that you found it fruitful.

Federal officials from the Department of Defense, Environmental Protection Agency, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention benefitted from hearing directly from you about your concerns and those of the communities you lead. I believe these agencies have a responsibility to be transparent and timely in their communication with communities affected by PFCs in their drinking water.

I also believe that our communities deserve answers about the effect this contamination may have on their health. I will continue to fight for a rigorous health study to be implemented, and I believe that the Department of Defense should pay for that study.
