This is a follow up to our letter of September 19, 2019. A tentative schedule for the water and sewer construction project(s) in your area has been established. The tentative schedule calls for mobilization in early January 2020. The schedule for the pump station at the end of Springbrook Lane has not been established but will be put on our website as soon as it becomes available. If your property is located in the 400-500 block of County Line Road, Holly Drive, Harcourt Lane or Buckman Drive, this work will not be occurring directly in your neighborhood; you are receiving this letter because once work starts it could slow down access to your neighborhood via County Line at Maple Avenue & Latchstring Lane.
