Re: Notice to Comply with HWSA PFC Interim Limits Resolution

Dear Colonel Eissler:

In order to protect the health and welfare of the Horsham community, and in accordance with an April 4, 2016 directive received from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) the Horsham Water & Sewer Authority (HWSA), at its meeting of April 12, 2016, adopted Resolution 2016-3 establishing interim limits and reporting requirements for PFCs discharged into the HWSA sewer system. Specifically, the resolution establishes an interim maximum concentration of 0.1 micrograms per liter (ug/l) for discharge of PFOA and an interim maximum concentration of 0.2 ug/l for discharge of PFOS.

Please be advised that the Air National Guard (ANG) must comply with the provisions of Resolution 2016-3 immediately. Therefore, and in furtherance of our letter to you dated April 4, 2016, you are hereby directed to sample your wastewater at the point of discharge to the HWSA sewer system within one (1) week of receipt of this notice, and to analyze said sample for concentrations of PFOA and PFOS in accordance with appropriate US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) laboratory analysis methods and protocols. Sample analytical results shall be submitted to HWSA within ten (10) days of conducting the required sampling.

Should the results of the sample analyses identify concentrations of PFOA and/or PFOS in excess of the interim limits established in the resolution, and if ANG wishes to continue to discharge sewage to the HWSA sewer system, then the HWSA shall issue a discharge permit to the ANG and shall require the pretreatment of sewage prior to discharge to concentration levels compliant with the resolution.
