



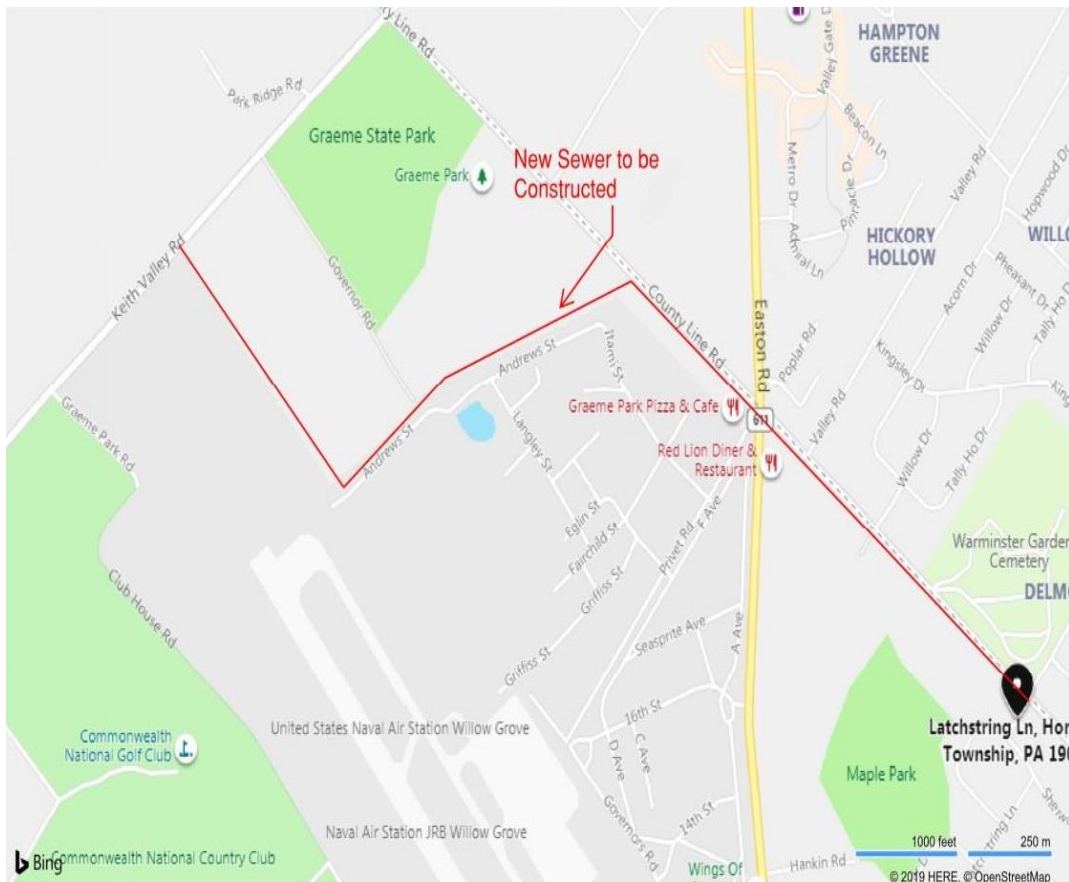

Re: Horsham Water & Sewer Authority
Area A Flow Transfer Project

Dear Resident,

We are writing to inform you of a sewer construction project in your area.

The work in the area of your property involves new sanitary sewer and associated manholes along County Line Road from Latchstring Lane, west through the intersection of 611 to the PECO substation located approximately 1500' west of 611. Work will then proceed along the boundary of the Horsham Air Guard Station, on to Horsham Township's Strawbridge Park and adjacent private property, to Keith Valley Road where there will be a connection to an existing sewer main. A map of the proposed new sewer is provided below:



Work is expected to begin within the next several weeks and will be ongoing for a period of approximately six months. All work on County Line Road will be performed at night between the hours of 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM. During this time there will be traffic controls in place, including lane closures and flagging. This may result in

delays throughout the project area during the overnight work hours. As always, access to emergency services will be maintained. Permanent pavement restoration will occur at the end of the project.

The contract for the work has been awarded to Ankiewicz Enterprises, Inc. of Tamaqua, PA.

Prior to the start of construction, you may see the contractor performing preconstruction video-taping. This is a requirement of the contract in order to document existing conditions throughout the work area and ultimately ensure that the area is properly restored.

As with all construction projects, weather and other factors can cause schedules to change faster than we can advise you by standard mail communication.
