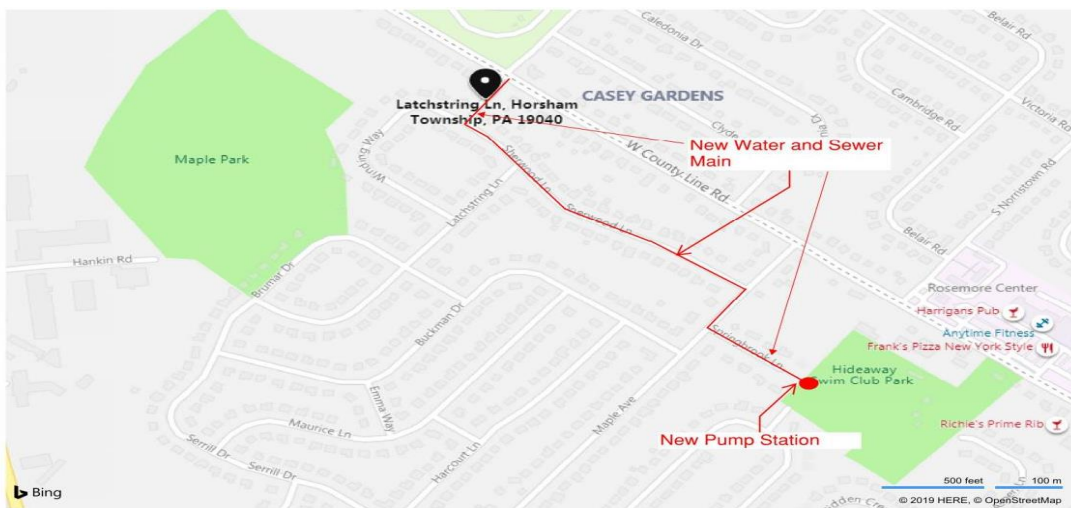
Re: Horsham Water & Sewer Authority
County Line Road Area Water Infrastructure Improvements
Area A Flow Transfer Sewer Project
Springbrook Lane and portions of Sherwood Lane Water Main Replacement
Springbrook Lane Pump Station

Dear Resident,

We are writing to inform you of a water and sewer construction project in your area that will begin soon. You may remember receiving correspondence regarding a water main replacement project last year. Part of this water project has been incorporated into a larger sewer project in the area to minimize construction impacts to residents. If you are served by public water and your home is currently connected to the water main being replaced, your water service will ultimately be disconnected from the existing water main and reconnected to the new main. This work will take place entirely within the Township right of way and does not involve any disturbance to your private property. There is no cost to you for this work, but when the time comes for your water service to be switched over to the new main, there will be a short interruption in service, in the range of 1-2 hours. This work will occur toward the end of the project, and will be coordinated directly with you at that time.

There will also be a new sewer pump station constructed on the Hideaway Swim Club property, with access to the pump station from a new driveway at the end of Springbrook Lane. Sewer service to your home will not be interrupted as the additional sewer main being installed is strictly for the purpose of conveying flows from the new pump station.

A map depicting the project area is provided below:



Work is expected to begin within the next several weeks and will be ongoing for a period of approximately six months. Road closure is not anticipated, but traffic controls will be in place and lanes will be restricted as necessary throughout the project area. As always, access to local traffic, emergency services and school busses will be

maintained. With the exception of any surface facilities being constructed, such as the pump station, shifting of fire hydrant(s), installation of valves and/or manholes, the work areas will be restored to as close to preconstruction conditions as possible. Permanent restoration will occur at the end of the project.

There are two contracts for the pipe work. The contract for pipe work in your neighborhood, which includes the water main replacement from Springbrook Lane to County Line Road, has been awarded to Almeida and Hudak Contractors of Plymouth Meeting, PA. The contract for the pipe work in County Line Road has been awarded to Ankiewicz Enterprises, Inc. of Tamaqua, PA.

The pump station work has been awarded to PSI Pumping Solutions, Inc., of York Springs, PA and AJM Electric, Inc. of Chester, PA.

Prior to the start of construction, you may see the contractors performing preconstruction video-taping. This is a requirement of the contract in order to document existing conditions throughout the work area and ultimately ensure that the area is properly restored.

There will be a separate project in the future to replace the rest of the water mains in your development; however, the timing of that project has not yet been determined.

As with all construction projects, weather and other factors can cause schedules to change faster than we can advise you by standard mail communication. In order that we may provide you with updates or schedule changes, if you have not already signed up for updates on the "County Line Road area infrastructure improvements" project, please do so.
