Re: County Line Road Area Water Infrastructure Improvements

Dear Resident,

You may recall having received a letter back in 2018 advising of a planned upgrade to the water infrastructure in your area. We are writing to inform you that the Authority has awarded a contract for the work to Joao & Bradley Construction Co., Inc. of Bethlehem, PA. The scope of work in this project includes water main and service line replacement as well as new water main extensions to improve water quality, flow and supply redundancy in your neighborhood. The water main to be replaced is located in existing roadways, and the new water main extensions will be installed within easements on Township, School District and private property.

If you are served by public water and your home is currently connected to the water main being replaced, your water service will ultimately be disconnected from the existing water main and reconnected to the new main. The water service to be replaced includes the portion of the service between the water main in the street and the shutoff valve in the front of your property. There is no cost to you for this work, but when the time comes for your water service to be switched over to the new main, there will be a short interruption in service, typically no longer that 1 hour. This work will occur toward the end of the project, and will be coordinated directly with you at that time.

A map depicting the project area is provided below:



A construction schedule will be provided as soon as it becomes available. In the meantime, and prior to the start of construction, you may see the contractors performing preconstruction video-taping. This is a requirement of the contract in order to document existing conditions throughout the work area and ultimately ensure that the area is properly restored.

A separate sewer project involving relining of the sewer mains in certain areas of your development is also currently out to bid. Additional information with regard to that project will be forthcoming as well. That work will overlap with the water main replacement.
